THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE ENGLISH HALF MARATHON FESTIVAL OF RUN) TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to introduce the following:-

Temporary Prohibition of Driving (Between the hours of 4:00am and 2:00pm):

Sankey Street – For its entire length

Winmarleigh Street – For its entire length

Temporary Prohibition of Driving (Between the hours of 5:00am and 2:00pm):

Entire lengths of road: -

Part lengths of road: -

Academy Street (Northwest bound) - Academy way to Scotland Road.

Ackers Road (Northeast bound) - Chester Road to Cantilever South West Approach.

Station Road - Wash Lane to Grammar School Road.

Academy Way - Moulders Lane to Bridge Street.

Chester Road A56 - Lumb Brook Road to Ackers Road.

Church Lane - Chester Road to Broad Lane.

Chester Road A56 (Westbound) - Ackers Road to Albert Road.

Leigh Street - Bath Street to Sankey Street.

Knutsford Road A5061 (Westbound) - Grange Avenue to Wilderspool Causeway.

Winwick Road (Unclassified) - Pinners Brow to the A49 Winwick Road.

Mersey Street (Northeast bound) - Wharf Street to Bank Street.

Temporary Prohibition of Driving (Between the hours of 8:55am and 9:20am):

Bridge Foot – For its entire length

Mersey Street – Bridge Street to Wharf Street.

Warrington Old Bridge – For its entire length.

Warrington New Bridge – For its entire length.

Wilson Patten Street – For its entire length.

Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn (Between the hours of 5:00am and 2:00pm):

Warrington New Bridge – To prohibit any vehicle proceeding on Warrington New Bridge from making a right hand turn onto Warrington Old Bridge.

Warrington Old Bridge - To prohibit any vehicle proceeding on Warrington Old Bridge from making a right hand turn into Mersey Street.

The Order will be effective from Sunday 16th September 2018 between the hours of 4.00am and 2:00pm. The restrictions will be in place as and when the relevant signs are on site. Access will be under the control of the event organiser for the duration of the event.

The alternative route will be via London Road, Wilderspool Causeway, Warrington New Bridge, Bridge Foot, Wilson Patten Street, Parker Street, Liverpool Road, Sankey Way, Priestley Street, Froghall Lane, Midland Way, Manchester Road, Kingsway North, Kingsway South, Knutsford Road, Cliff Lane and vice versa.

The restrictions are required to facilitate The English Half Marathon Festival of Run.
