18. Neighbourhood Plan Update

The NDP Steering Group has continued to meet on a regular basis. The consultants ONH Planning for Good met with the group on 30 April to consider the potential scope of the Neighbourhood Plan and the consultants have drafted an advice note to be shared with the group.

The advice note indicates that the Neighbourhood Plan opportunities take two forms: shaping the major development proposals within their boundaries and managing change in the existing urban Parish, some of which will be prompted by the major development proposals. The main policy opportunities identified by the consultants are design coding; green infrastructure; local heritage; housing types and tenure mix; local green spaces; site specific provisions and infrastructure investment priorities.

A further meeting is scheduled with the consultants for 15 May firstly to discuss the bigger picture, project management and communications and secondly to agree the details of an action plan.

Grant Application to Grappenhall and Thelwall Parish Council

Damp Works to the Old Barn

The damp works on the Olde Barn, for which you kindly gave a grant of £3,000 in December 2023, have subsequently been completed.

However, the final cost of the works necessarily came in in excess of the estimate at £5,552.50 plus VAT and the GYCA also incurred a further decoration cost of £1,800 necessary to make good the appearance of the Olde Barn ahead of re-opening for business.

Front Doors

Due to deterioration over time, it has now been necessary for reasons of both appearance and security to replace the front doors leading into both the Bellhouse Club / the Olde Barn and additionally also the front doors to the Grappenhall Pre-School / Sports Hall / Studio

The total cost for this work, from K&L Joinery a local Warrington based supplier, was £3,607 plus VAT.

Whilst we have produced forecasts for the current period which show that our business will continue to operate profitably in the present difficult economic climate and we are in the midst of a medium term review on how to attract income from new sources / clients, the Trustees and Management of the GYCA would much appreciate any further financial support that the Parish Council can provide.

We do appreciate the varied demands on your limited resources, but would trust that you would see the benefit in further supporting such a key local asset as the Community Centre.
